MEAL ACCOUNTS

MY SCHOOL BUCKS

All students have a MySchoolBucks account already setup in the district database. You can also open a parent account online.

PRE-PAYMENTS

Parents are responsible for funding the account and keeping it from becoming overdrawn (negative). The pre-payment is used against your child(ren) purchases like a debit account.

PRICES

Lunch cost \$3.50 per day and includes items listed on the menu. We also offer a limited number of a la carte items. On average a \$100 deposit per month is recommended. This will pay for 28 lunches.

HOW STUDENTS PLACE AN ORDER

Each morning, your teacher will ask each student if they will be ordering lunch in the cafeteria and the menu items of their choice. This order is then sent to our central kitchen, and prepared. Please remind your child(ren) to take what they ordered, otherwise they are taking someone else's order.

HOW MEALS ARE PURCHASED

Elementary School students, do not need an ID card to make their purchases. The cashier will ask them their name, and look up their account.

FACTS ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

MBUSD Food & Nutrition Services (FNS), operates under strict USDA Federal and State Laws & Regulations for all meals and foods served in schools. The 'School Meal' is the most regulated meal in America.

FNS contracts with SNS, a company that monitors the Safety and Sanitation of our kitchens and provides on-going training to our staff in these areas.

On average FNS employees have worked at MBUSD for 15 years. Some have been here for 30 years. They love serving the students and being part of their lives.

Our dairy products do not contain high fructose corn syrup.

We only serve Whole Grain Rich products that contain a minimum of 51% WG.

We do not use or serve any products containing trans fats. Nothing is fried.

We serve locally grown fresh fruit and produce daily.

We strive to please all tastes and palates, while serving wholesome and fresh food that is age appropriate.

Brand name items you see on the menu are formulated specifically for School Child Nutrition programs. They are not the same as the retail version that you may purchase in a store or restaurant.

All food is prepared onsite by MBUSD Food & Nutrition Services staff.

NOTE Non-compliant foods, sold by Student/Parent Organizations may be served from one-half hour after school ends through midnight only. Otherwise foods must be pre-approved by the School District's Governing Board. The sale must occur after lunch period has ended. The food or beverage cannot be prepared on campus and the food or beverage item cannot be the same item sold in the Food Service Program.
